Investing in Brownfields

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - ▶ Fund the Clean Ohio Revitalization Fund
 - ► Nearly \$40 million in funding available through the reallocation of liquor profits the state receives each year from JobsOhio

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - ► Maintain Support for Public Transit
 - Transit has been a vital service throughout the coronavirus pandemic
 - Retain \$70 million approved in funding two years ago to maintain this necessary service

Innovate Infrastructure & Transportation

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - ▶ Invest in Preservation, Not Expansion
 - Prioritizing preservation and repair projects would not only address the existing maintenance needs across the state, but this shift would generate more jobs than capacity-building and expansion projects

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - ▶ Invest in Broadband Infrastructure
 - Lack of access is a problem in both rural communities and marginalized neighborhoods in our urban core
 - Funding + Access to public right-of-way "smart corridors" can help to bridge the gap

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - Preserve Long-Term City Investments
 - Suspension of the 20-Day Rule was a necessary response to the coronavirus pandemic
 - Lifting the suspension could negatively impact Ohio cities by as much as \$411 million per year

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - ▶ Stabilize Our Downtowns & Commercial Centers
 - ► Financial support to small businesses, including commercial rent relief, access to risk-tolerant capital & invest in worker safety

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - ► Ensure Capacity Building in State Programs
 - Help local governments obtain & retain skills, knowledge & tools needed to become vibrant, prosperous connected places

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - ▶ Prevent New Cycles of Blight & Disinvestment
 - ▶ Tax amnesty and reform to outdates land contract law will prevent home vacancy

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - ▶ Provide Strategic Investment in Neighborhoods
 - ► Façade & streetscaping improvements, public art, mixed-use development & transit-oriented development improve the livability of cities and neighborhoods capitalizing on existing assets and attracting new residents

- ▶ To Build a Greater Ohio...
 - Protect Ohio Families through Housing
 - ► Eviction & foreclosure moratoriums provide temporary relief to an emerging crisis in housing. Rental assistance programs for residents and access to risk-tolerant capital for landlords will protect families and help restart the economy
