Todd Kinskey is a certified professional planner who joined the City of Dayton in May of 2018 as its Director of Planning & Community Development (PCD). In June of 2021, PCD was merged with the Department of Economic Development to form the new Department of Planning, Neighborhoods & Development. Todd oversees the daily operations of this new department (91 employees) and its six Divisions including: Planning, Community Engagement, Development, Housing & Inspections, Building Services, and the Dayton Mediation Center. He is responsible for an annual budget of approximately \$10.0M in operating funds and more than \$30.0M in special project and grant funds. Prior to his appointment in Dayton, he was employed by Hamilton County, Ohio for over 23 years serving as Planning Director for almost 10 years. He has 28+ years of experience as a professional planner with emphasis in long range planning, community development, economic development, site plan review, land use planning and zoning analysis.

Todd holds a bachelor's degree in Urban Planning from the University of Cincinnati College of Design Art Architecture and Planning. He has experience serving on numerous boards and commissions including as President of the Ohio Chapter of the American Planning Association in 2015-16. Todd was inducted into the American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP) College of Fellows in April 2020.
